- 4. **Community Outreach and Defense Report:** The goal of this committee is to connect with communities at risk. Recent meeting on Southwest Side of city had about 45 people in attendance. Discussed positive changes such as the new Price Rite store; Food Co-ops; and the possibility of a Festival for the area similar to the Westcott Festival. Issues they want addressed: not well presented politically; all politicians should be held accountable at all levels, local, state and national; train people to get active; anger regarding pressure to purchase flood plain insurance.
- 5. **Update on Listserv Bounce Project:** many email addresses are being bounced back and volunteers are working to correct where possible. If you are not receiving the Monday morning email sent to the entire coalition, please sign up again at the next meeting.
- 6. **Proposal of Purview Committee:** the proposal (copy attached) is about who makes which decisions, i.e. (which decisions are with the full coalition, the Committees and the Coordinating Committee). The Purview committee will review, makes changes where applicable and present back to the Coalition.
- 7. **Finance Committee Proposal:** The proposal outlines how to deal with the current treasury (\$600) on a cash basis. At this time, all funds are received and paid out in cash. The current proposal outlines the controls for the secure storage of cash and how to seek advance payment/reimbursement for approved expenses. For expenditures greater than \$100 it was proposed that the full Coalition be asked for approval via an online survey and only a simple majority of votes cast

would be required for approval. After a vote today to not accept the proposal as is, it was decided that the Finance Committee would review alternatives to online voting and using a simple majority vote for approval.
